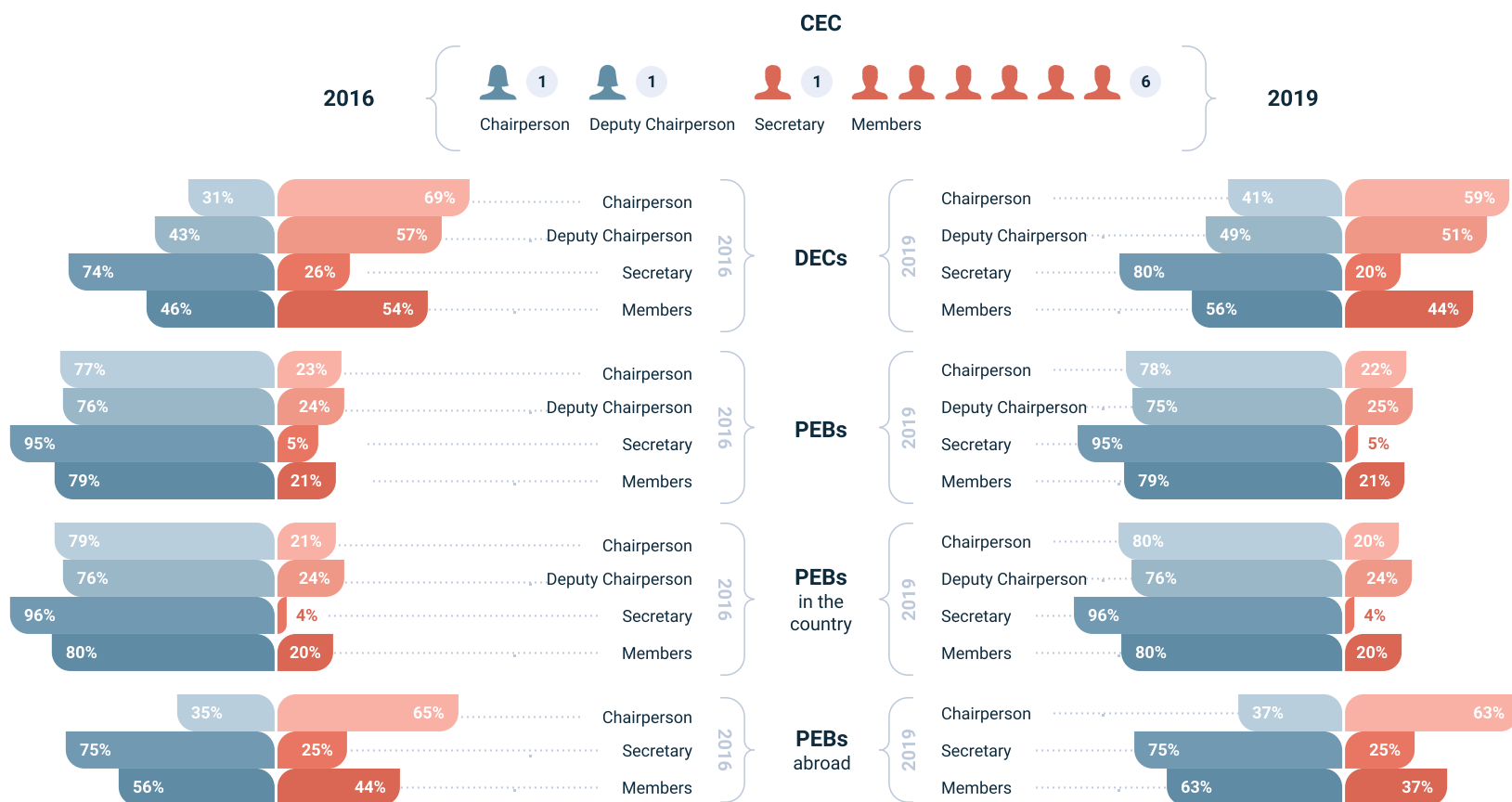

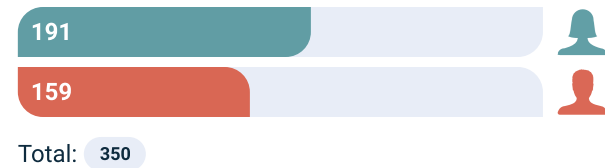

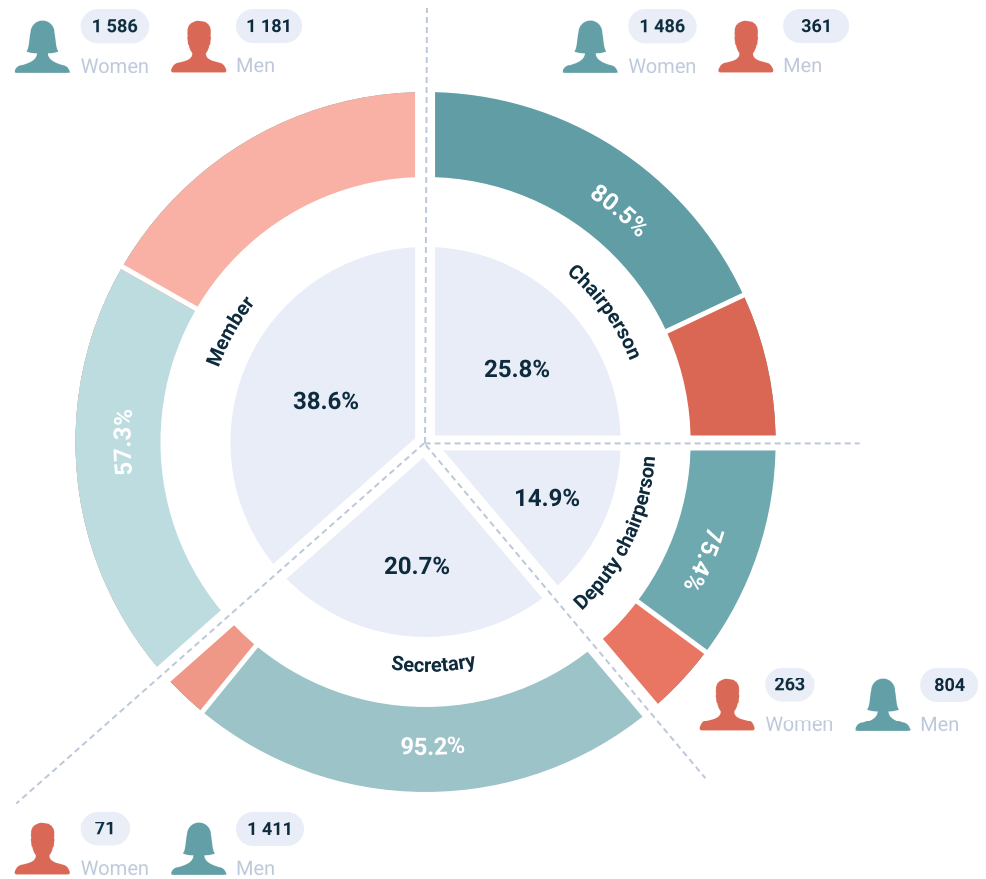

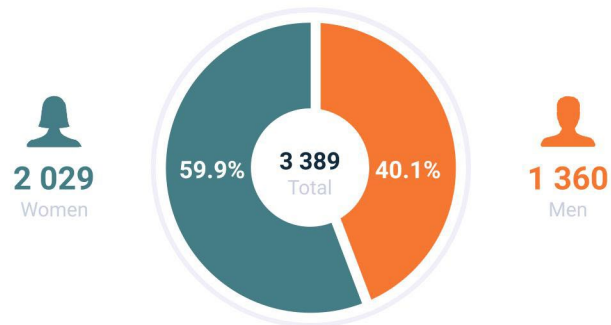

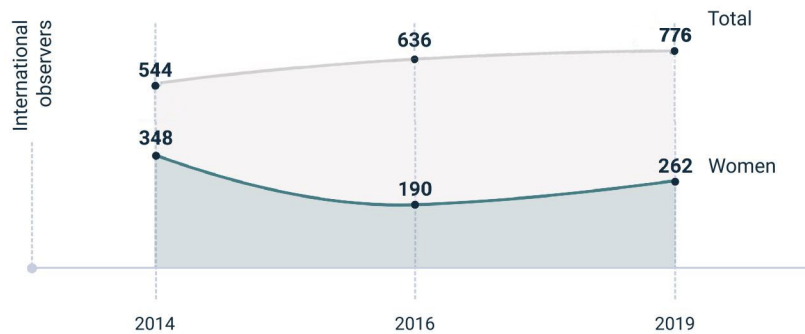
3.3. Share of women among national observers

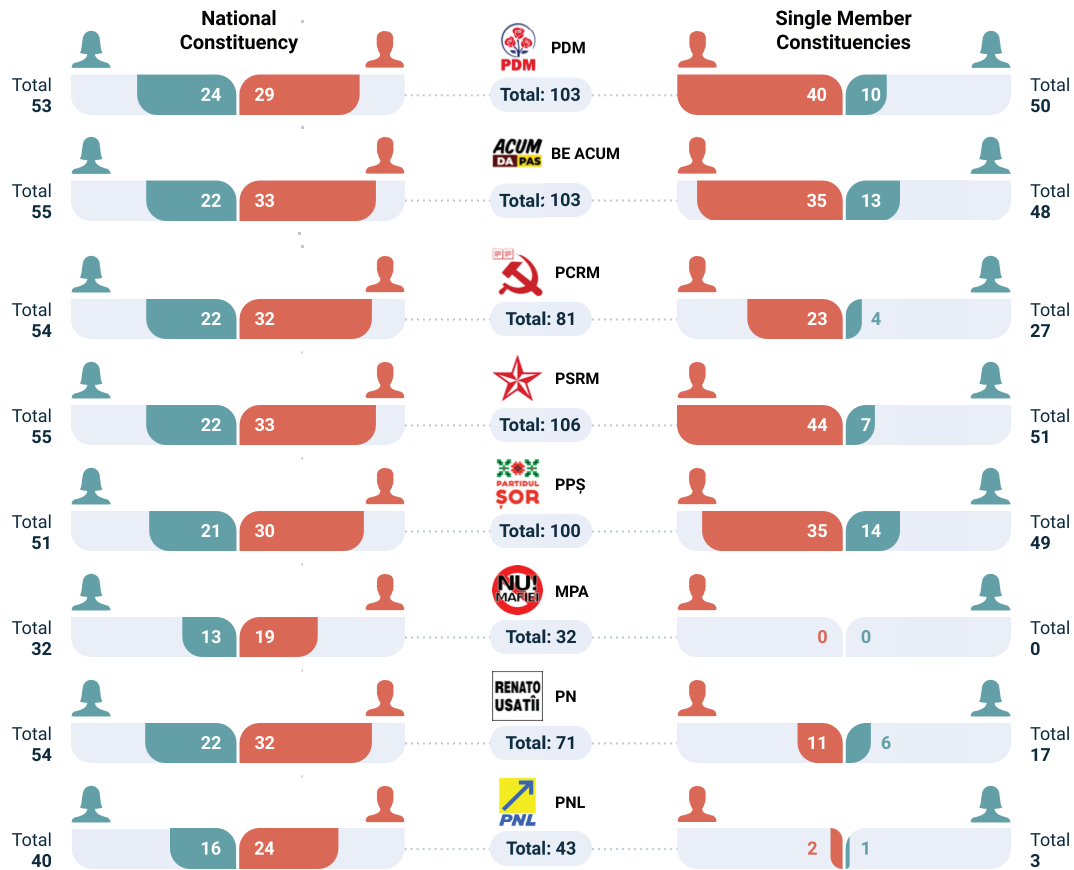

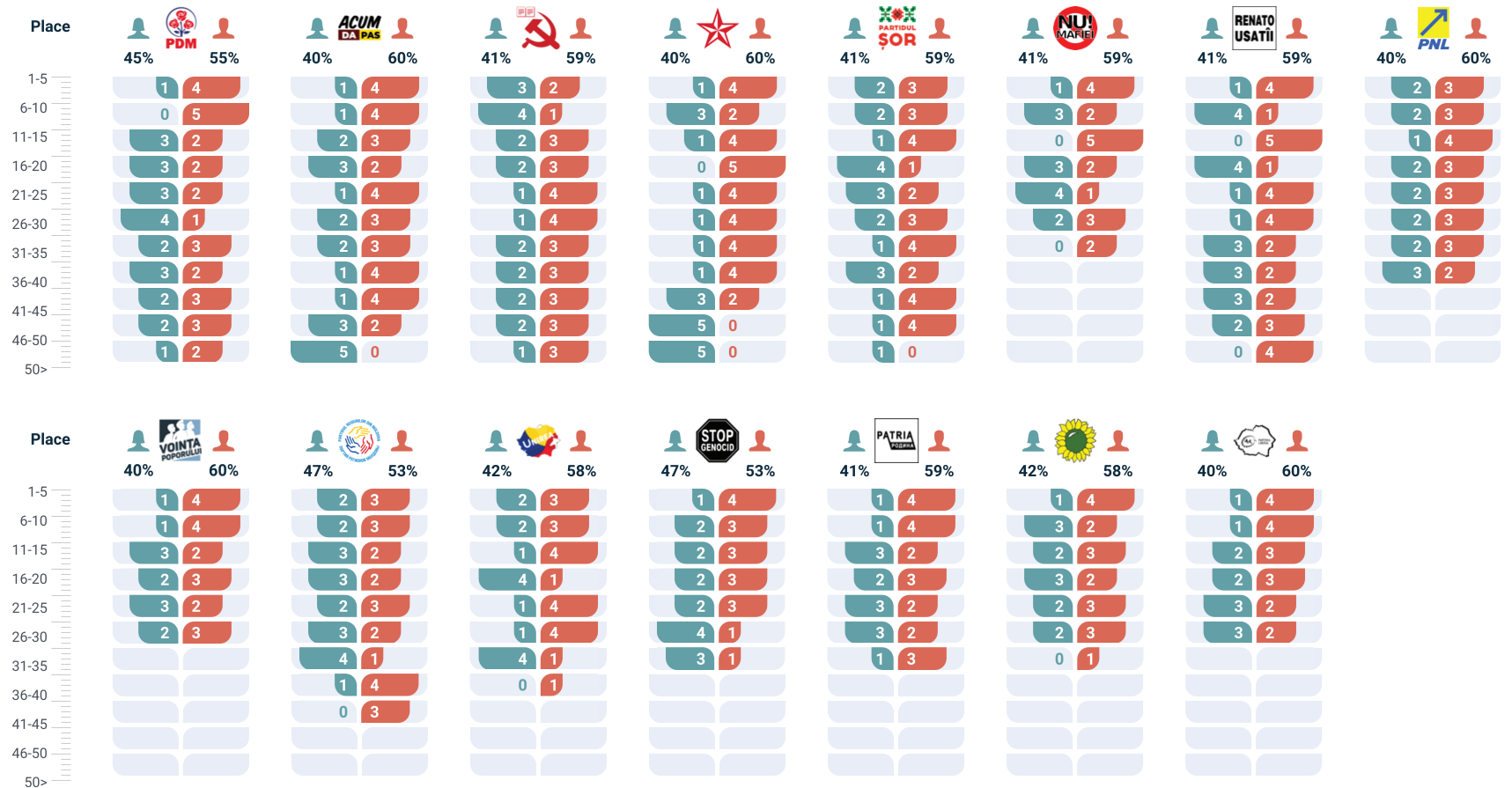

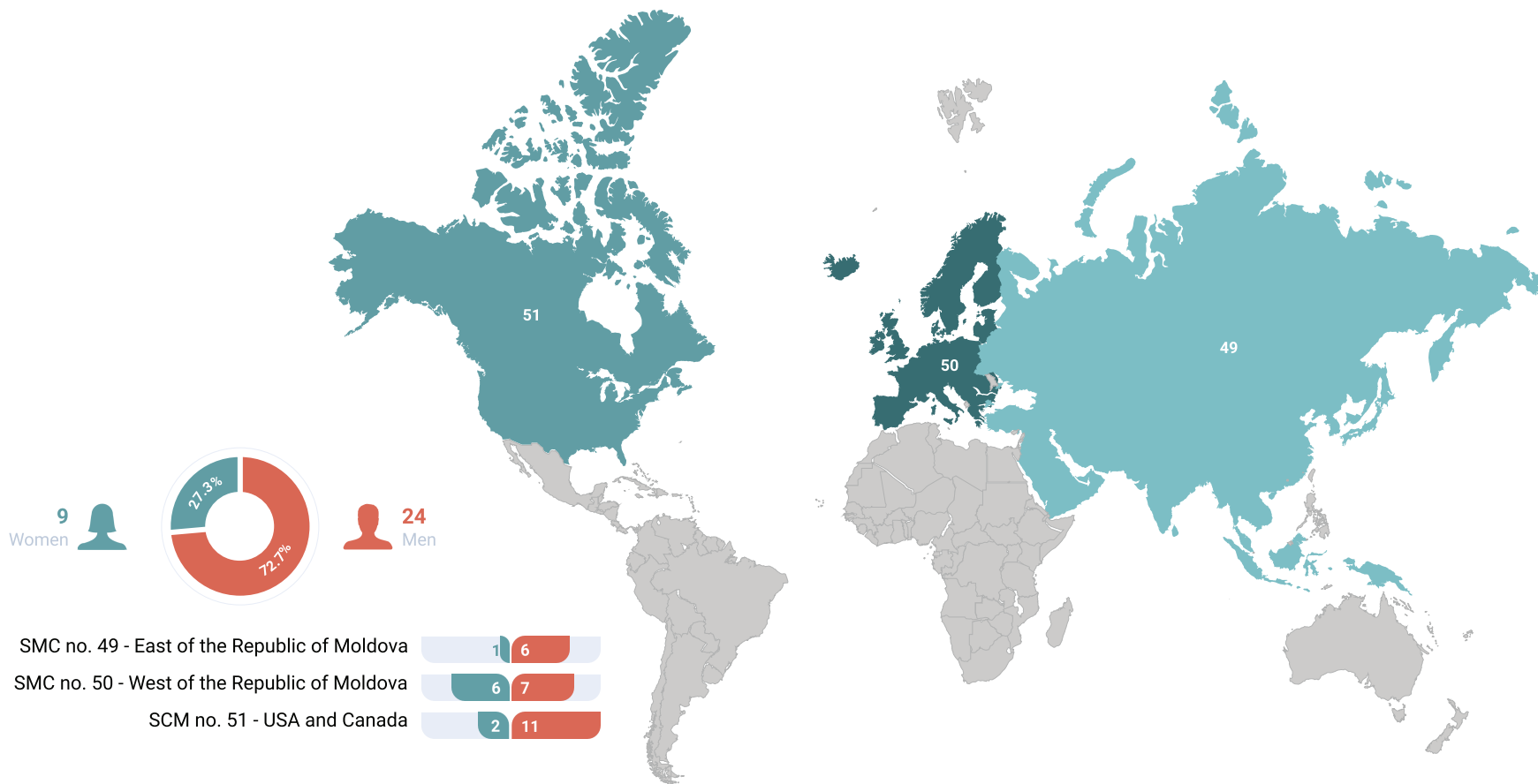

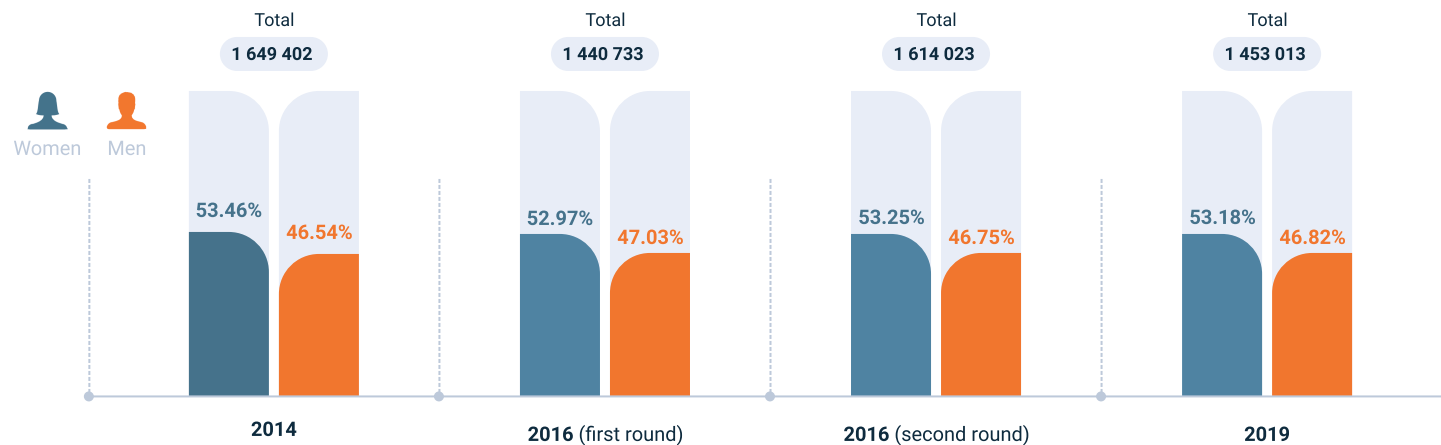

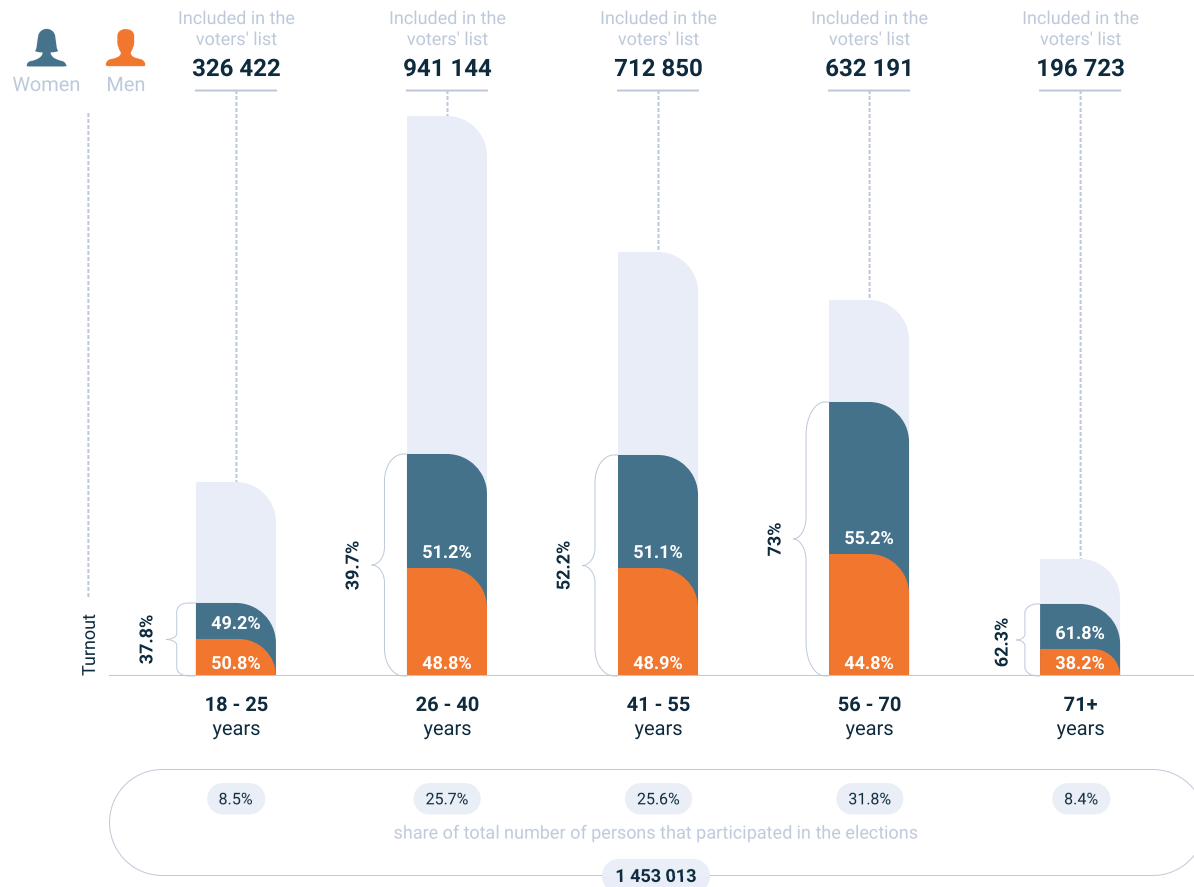

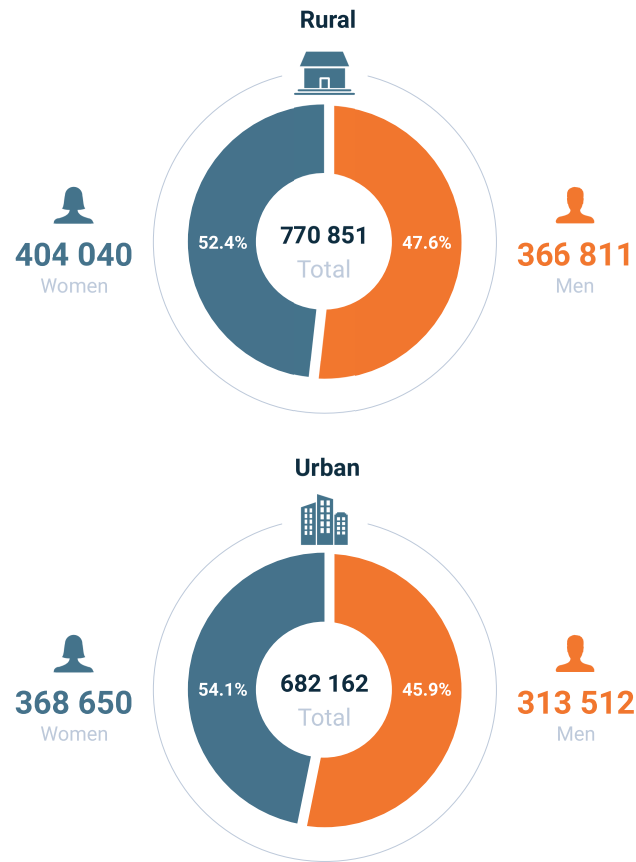

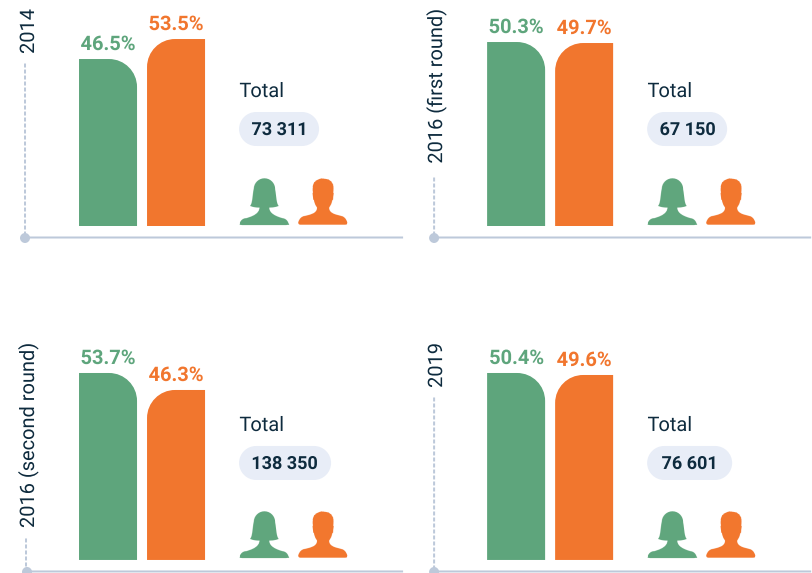

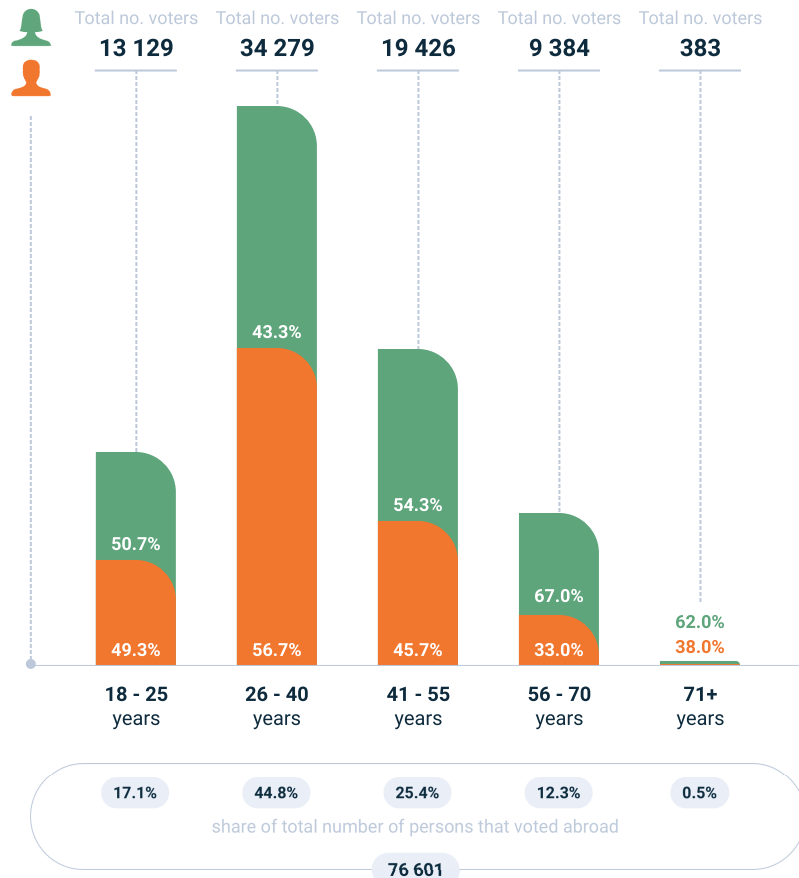

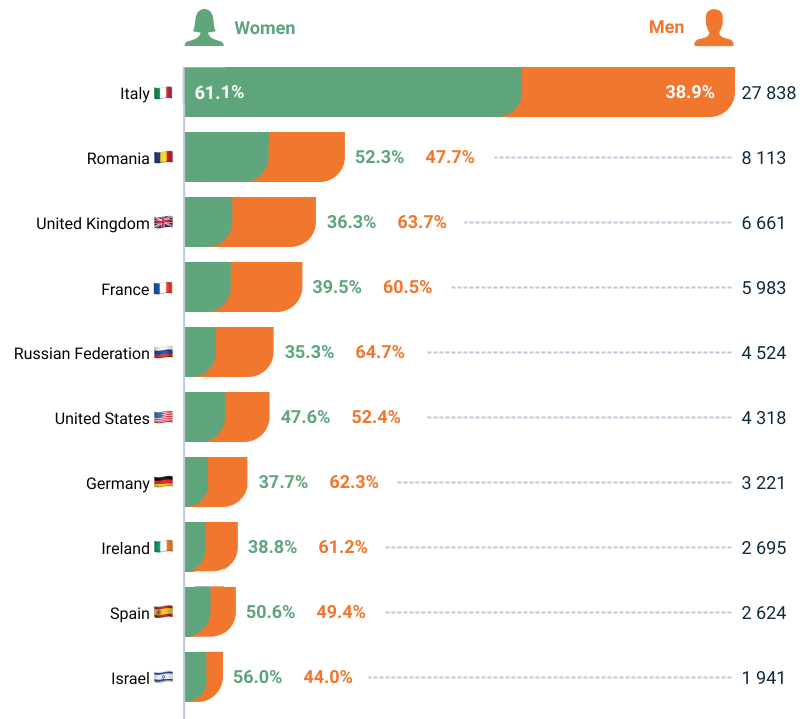

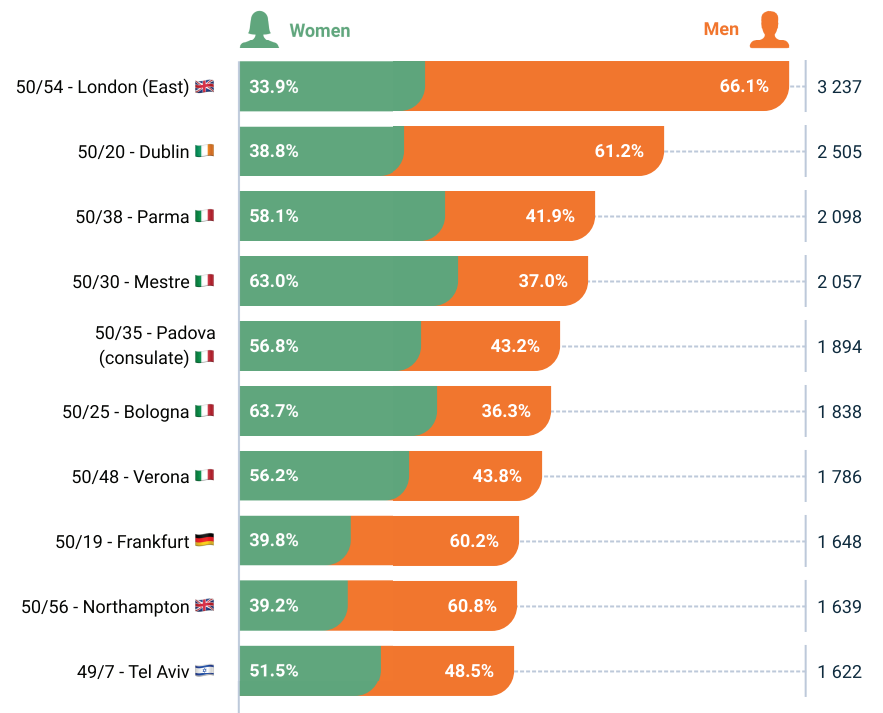

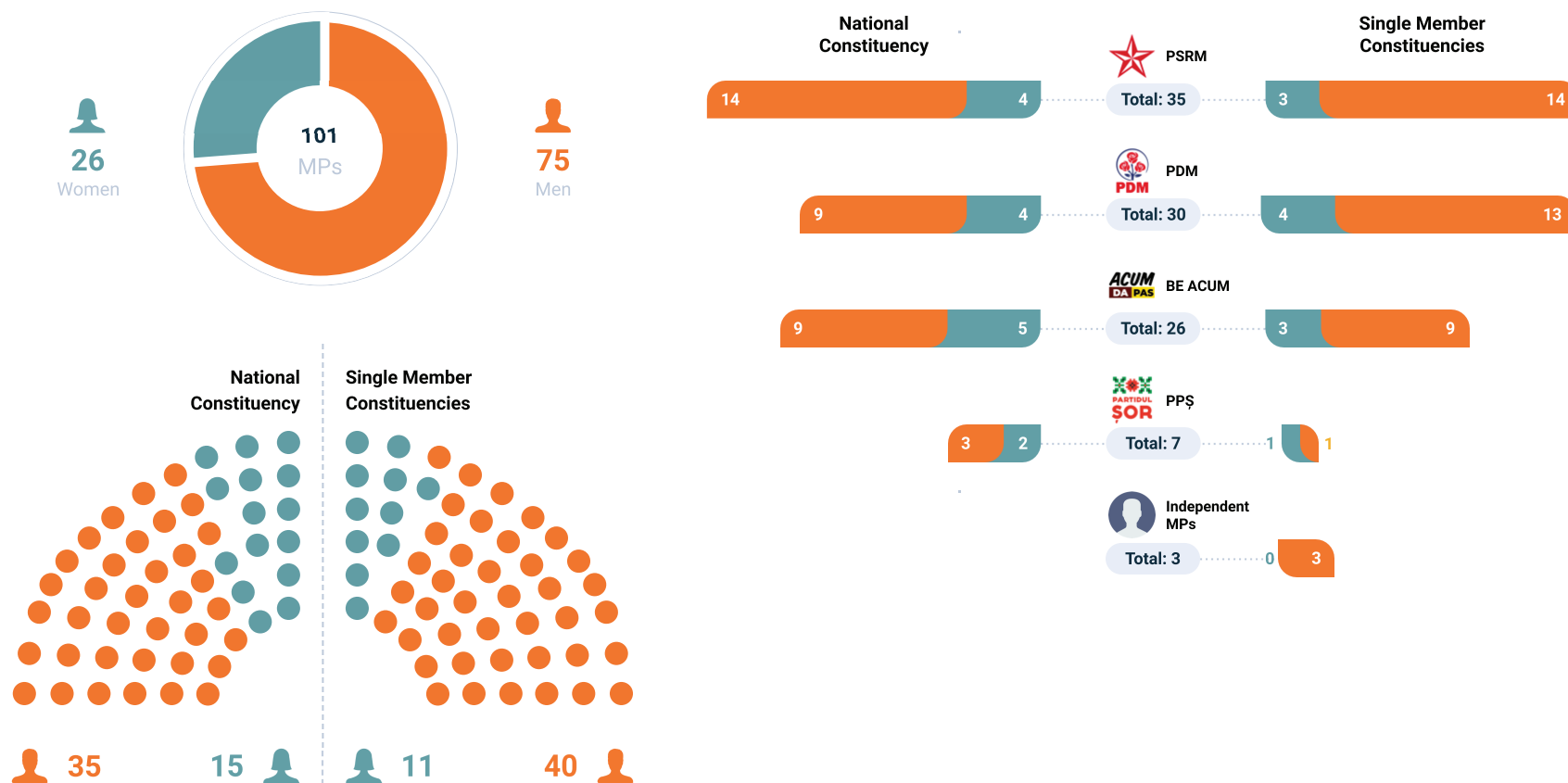


6.6. Top 10 polling stations abroad with the highest voter participation



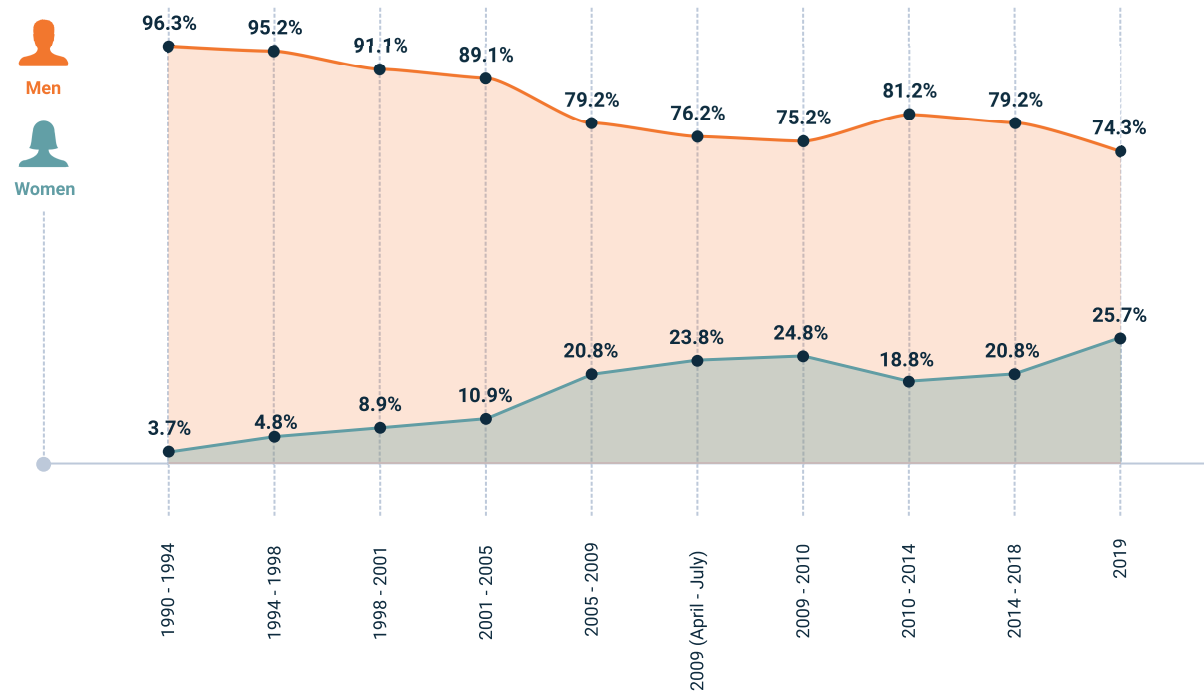
